- Assist in Warehouse and other departments as needed
- Follow and enforce all safety guidelines and requirements including proper personal protective equipment for employees and visitors

QUALIFICATIONS/ REQUIREMENTS

- High school diploma or equivalent, required
- Technical School training preferred with an emphasis in mechanics and electronics

- Must have extensive knowledge of mechanics and electricity
- Preferred knowledge and/or experience of welding processes
- Must be able to maneuver all equipment and tools
- Ability to read and comprehend vendor repair manuals and instructions
- Ability to count and write to accurately take inventory count and complete necessary paperwork
- Ability to perform heavy work – routinely lifting 25 – 75 pounds from floor to waist and occasionally lifting 76 to greater than 100 pounds from floor to waist
- Ability to communicate and interact well with others
- Ability to work overtime and some Saturday hours as needed
- Must be able to stand for long periods of time
- Must be able to frequently stoop, twist, kneel, bend and climb ladders
- Ability to operate and use all equipment
- Ability to work independently with little supervision
- Vision correctable to within normal range for vehicle driving, report completion, and operation of all equipment
